The scores in the first and fourth matches in the above table both added up to **230**. This is easily the highest aggregate score in the Cup, at least since the 2016-17 season.

The **Poachers**' score of 134 was the second highest score in the Cup since the 2016–17 season. (The Queens scored 135 in Round 1, in 2019-20).
